NOTICE OF REGULATIONS APPROVED

After proceedings held in accordance with and pursuant to authority vested in Sections 142, 142.3 and 142.4 of the Labor Code to implement, interpret, or make specific, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, by a majority vote, adopted additions, revisions or deletions to the California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Chapter 4, as follows:

1. Title 8, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, General Industry Safety Orders, Article 76, Section 4650, Compressed Gas (Oxygen) Cylinder Storage.

Heard at the January 20, 2005, Public Hearing; adopted on November 17, 2005; filed with the Secretary of State on December 5, 2005; and will become effective on January 4, 2006.

2. Title 8, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, General Industry Safety Orders, Article 10, Section 3395, Heat Illness Prevention (Emergency Standard).

Adopted on December 15, 2005; filed with the Secretary of State on December 20, 2005; became effective on December 20, 2005; and expires on April 20, 2006.
