NOTICE OF REGULATIONS APPROVED

After proceedings held in accordance with and pursuant to authority vested in Sections 142, 142.3 and 142.4 of the Labor Code to implement, interpret, or make specific, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, by a majority vote, adopted additions, revisions or deletions to the California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Chapter 4, as follows:

1. Title 8: Chapter 7, Subchapter 18, Ship Building, Ship Repairing, and Ship Breaking Safety Orders, Article 3, Section 8354; and Article 8, Sections 8397, 8397.10, 8397.11, 8397.12 and 8397.13, Fire Protection in Shipyard Employment.

Heard at the February 17, 2005, Public Hearing; adopted on March 17, 2005; filed with the Secretary of State on April 14, 2005; and became effective on April 14, 2005.

2. Title 8: Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, Construction Safety Orders, Article 21, Section 1637, Scaffold Ladders.

Heard at the February 17, 2005, Public Hearing; adopted on March 17, 2005; filed with the Secretary of State on April 28, 2005; and will become effective on May 28, 2005.

3. Title 8: Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, General Industry Safety Orders, Article 13, Section 3456, Hand Weeding, Hand Thinning, and Hand-Capping Operations in Agriculture.

Heard at the November 18, 2004, Public Hearing; adopted on March 17, 2005; filed with the Secretary of State on April 29, 2005; and became effective on April 29, 2005.
