1. Title 8; Division 1; Chapter 4; Subchapter 7; General Industry Safety Orders; Articles 76, 81 and 85; Sections 4650, 4797 and 4823; **Acetylene (Horcher).**

Heard at the April 15, 2010, Public Hearing; adopted on May 20, 2010; filed with the Secretary of State on July 1, 2010; and became effective on July 1, 2010.
