## **NOTICE OF STANDARDS APPROVED**

After proceedings held in accordance with and pursuant to authority vested in Sections 142, 142.3 and 142.4 of the Labor Code to implement, interpret, or make specific, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, by a majority vote, adopted additions, revisions or deletions to the California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Chapter 4, as follows:

1. Title 8; Chapter 4; Subchapter 4; Construction Safety Orders; Articles 16, 17 and 18; Sections 1620, 1626 and 1629; **Railings and Stairways.**

Heard at the June 15, 2006, Public Hearing; adopted on March 15, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on April 20, 2007; and will become effective on May 20, 2007.

2. Title 8, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, General Industry Safety Orders, Articles 98 and 101, Sections 5004 and 5047; and Subchapter 18; Ship Building, Ship Repairing and Ship Breaking Safety Orders; Article 6; Section 8379; **Use of Personnel Suspended Platforms from Crane or Derrick.**

Heard at the October 19, 2006, Public Hearing; adopted on March 15, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on April 24, 2007; and will become effective on May 24, 2007.

3. Title 8, Chapter 4, Construction Safety Orders, Article 34, Section 1801 and Tunnel Safety Orders, Article 6, Section 8416, **Update of ANSI Z136.1 Laser Safety Standards, Warning Signs, Labeling, and Posting of Signs.**

Heard at the February 15, 2007, Public Hearing; adopted on March 15, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on April 27, 2007; and will become effective on May 27, 2007.
