PROPOSED STATE STANDARD,
TITLE 8, CHAPTER 4

Amend Section 6368 to read as follows:

§ 6368. Fuel Houses, Chip Bins, and Hoppers.

(a) Fuel houses shall be provided with at least two exits.

~~(b) Fuel houses, chip bins, and hoppers shall be constructed or equipped with tunnels, chains, mechanical diggers, vibrators, or other effective means of removing the material so that employees are not required to work where there is a possibility of being trapped in a cave in.~~
Sawmill operations involving fuel houses, chip bins, and hoppers, shall comply with the requirements of Section 3482 of the General Industry Safety Orders.

~~(c) Platforms and walkways shall be provided where employees work over material stored in fuel houses. They shall be constructed as required in the General Industry Safety Orders.~~

~~(d) No employee shall leave the walkways or protected areas in fuel houses, bins and hoppers, without wearing an approved safety belt and a line attended by another employee.~~
