ORDER OF THE LABOR  
COMMISSIONER ON STIPULATION  
TO DEBARMENT

21 Whereas, Respondent stipulated to debarment as follows:

- 22 1. Respondent Fast Demolition, Inc. is the holder of California Contractor's  
23 license number 792729.  
24  
25 2. Respondent Rogelio M. Vazquez is an individual who is and was at all  
26 relevant times the RMO of Fast Demolition, Inc.

1           3. Respondents entered into the attached SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT  
2 AND RELEASE including a DEBARMENT STIPULATION, see Paragraph 6,  
3 subsection C.

4           4. Based on the DEBARMENT STIPULATION, Respondents FAST  
5 DEMOLITION, INC. and ROGELIO M. VAZQUEZ shall be ineligible for a period of  
6 three years, beginning April 1, 2036, to do either of the following:  
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8                   A) Bid on or be awarded a contract for a public works project; or

9                   B) Perform work as a subcontractor on a public works project as defined  
10 as Labor Code sections 1720, 1720.2, and 1720.3.
