- I. Call to Order/Roll Call
  - a. Chairperson Burri called the meeting to order at approximately 1:30pm.

- II. Review/Approve Previous Minutes
  - a. Members approved the minutes from the previous meeting held on October 23, 2024.
- III. Introduction/Presentation – Jeanne-Mairie Duval, DAS Outreach Manager
  - a. Jeanne-Mairie Duval introduced herself as the new DAS Outreach Manager after being promoted from a communications role.
