This letter acknowledges a relationship between the East Los Angeles Women’s Center (ELAWC) and Building Skills Partnership’s Ya Basta Center Project. ELAWC is an organization which works to address and prevent sexual violence, offering the following services to survivors of sexual assault, their families and significant others of victims of sexual harassment, misconduct and abuse. ELAWC serves the Greater East Los Angeles, Southeast Los Angeles, Boyle Heights, City of Los Angeles and provides the following services:

- Bi-lingual trauma informed services that are culturally responsive to the Latinx community
- Crisis Intervention Services: 24-hour, 7-day-a-week confidential telephone crisis line
- Follow-up Services: Confidential client/survivor contact to ensure continuity of services
- Individual Counseling Services: Provision of confidential in-person counseling services.
- Group Counseling Services: Confidential support groups for sexual assault clients/survivors.
- Accompaniment & Advocacy Services: Confidential support & advocacy for sexual assault clients/survivors by being physically present, advocating during meetings or appointments.
- Information and Referral: Provision of sexual assault-related information.
- Community Education

ELAWC agrees to serve as a resource for sexual assault-related client/survivor referrals from BSP’s Ya Basta Center Project. This referral agreement will be effective from June 1, 2023 - December 31, 2024, with the ability to extend or renew beyond this date.
