ORDER OF SUSPENSION

MOUSTAFA ABOSHADY,

10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
12 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been
13 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

14 WHEREAS, on or about September 21, 2018, Moustafa Aboshady pled guilty to or was
15 found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section
16 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, District of Massachusetts; and

17 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to
18 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
19 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, due
20 to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

21 WHEREAS, Moustafa Aboshady was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the
22 federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

23 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to
24 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
25 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or
26 approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

27 WHEREAS, on or about June 16, 2022, Moustafa Aboshady's license, certification or
28 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California Medical

1 Board, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

2 WHEREAS, on or about December 1, 2022, the Administrative Director mailed to
3 Moustafa Aboshady a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the
4 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and
5 California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
7 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Moustafa Aboshady that the
8 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,
9 unless Moustafa Aboshady submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar
10 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

11 WHEREAS, Moustafa Aboshady did not submit a written request for hearing within ten
12 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

13 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
14 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and title 8, California Code of
15 Regulations section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless
16 the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10)
17 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;

18 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Moustafa Aboshady is hereby suspended from
19 participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
