ORDER OF SUSPENSION

DANIEL CAPEN,

Respondent.

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, on or about August 24, 2018, Daniel Capen pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in United States District Court, Central District of California; and


WHEREAS, on or about February 15, 2019, the Administrative Director mailed to Daniel Capen a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, Daniel Capen did submit a timely written request for hearing but prior to the scheduled hearing, withdrew his request to appeal the suspension; and

WHEREAS, there is no request to appeal the suspension and based on a review of the record, the Administrative Director finds that Daniel Capen meets the criteria for suspension set forth in Labor Code section 139.21(a);

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Daniel Capen is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
