5 ORDER OF SUSPENSION

6 In Re: PROVIDER SUSPENSION

7 TAMARA DIAZ,

8 Respondent.

9 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to  
10 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation  
11 system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony  
12 or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

13 WHEREAS, on or about August 12, 2013, Tamara Diaz pled guilty to or was found guilty  
14 of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in  
15 United States District Court, Central District of California; and

16 WHEREAS, on or about February 23, 2018, the Administrative Director mailed to Tamara  
17 Diaz a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to  
18 follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code  
19 of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of  
21 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised Tamara Diaz that the suspension  
22 would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Tamara  
23 Diaz submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of  
24 mailing of the notice; and

25 WHEREAS, Tamara Diaz did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)  
26 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

27 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner,  
28 or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations  
section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date of notice was mailed, unless the physician,  
practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of  
the date of mailing of the notice;

1           **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** Tamara Diaz is hereby suspended from participating in  
2 the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
