Based upon a review of the record in this case, including the January 25, 2024 Determination and Order Re: Suspension of Golden State Diagnostics, Inc., issued by Hearing Office and Workers' Compensation Judge Michael K. Greenberg, the Administrative Director finds that Respondent Golden State Diagnostics, Inc. meets the criteria for suspension set forth in Labor Code section 139.21(a) and shall be suspended from participating in the California workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider. Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.3(d), the Administrative Director hereby adopts and incorporates the January 25, 2024 Determination and Order Re: Suspension of Golden State Diagnostics, Inc..

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
