ORDER OF SUSPENSION

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, on or about November 17, 2015, Alan C. Ivar pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court for the Central District of California; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 22, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to Alan C. Ivar a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised Alan C. Ivar that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Alan C. Ivar submitted a written request for a hearing, within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Alan C. Ivar, through counsel, requested a hearing by letter dated March 15, 2017, a date outside of the ten (10) calendar day statutory time period for requesting a hearing based on the written notice dated February 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section

9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing, within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Alan C. Ivar is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
