WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised Elaine Lat that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Elaine Lat submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Elaine Lat did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)

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WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date of notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;
