**STATE OF CALIFORNIA** DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS **DIVISION OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION** BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR 5 In Re: PROVIDER SUSPENSION 6 PAUL MANSOUR, **ORDER OF SUSPENSION** 7 **Respondent.** 10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director 12 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been 14 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); 15 and 16 WHEREAS, on or about March 8, 2023, Respondent Paul Mansour pled guilty to or 17 was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 18 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, Central District of California; and 19 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director 20 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification, 22 or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and 23 WHEREAS, on or about February 1, 2024, Paul Mansour's license, certification, or 24 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California 25 Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs; and 26 WHEREAS, on or about May 13, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to Paul

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Mansour a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the

procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Paul Mansour that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Paul Mansour submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Paul Mansour did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Paul Mansour is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
