ORDER OF SUSPENSION

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification, or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 27, 2020, Respondent Ezequiel Martinez, Sr.'s license, certification, or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Physician Assistant Board, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, on or about August 13, 2025, the Administrative Director mailed to Ezequiel Martinez, Sr. a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Ezequiel Martinez, Sr. that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Ezequiel Martinez, Sr. submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Ezequiel Martinez, Sr. did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

1 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
2 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of
3 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was
4 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a
5 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

6 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Ezequiel Martinez, Sr. is hereby
7 suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician,
8 practitioner, or provider.
