SUBJECT: WRITTEN REQUEST FOR A HEARING TO STOP SUSPENSION OF PARTICIPATION  
IN CALIFORNIA'S WORKERS' COMPENSATION SYSTEM

Dear MR. PARISOTTO:

I am requesting a hearing to "STOP" the pending suspension of my participation in workers' compensation system. I also beg of you to book the hearing for a time that I can attend after the current incarceration is over, next year; or my case is appealed or pardoned. I am currently working on both. As I have practically no resources available while incarcerated to properly respond and appeal your documents, again I beg you to delay the hearing and suspension until I am released. I am not able to type responses, access any files, and am only able to send limited correspondence for the next eight months. Please note that the circumstances leading to conviction and sentencing (of which I am innocent) occurred while I had a large brain tumor, Craniotomy at UCLA and subsequent massive intracranial hemorrhage. I now believe that I was wrongly forced to sign a 'plea agreement' and did not commit "fraud"; while under great duress.

Please accept this letter in lieu of the proper response and documentation as under the current incarceration I am unable to respond appropriately, until I am released next year, or hopefully sooner.
