ORDER OF SUSPENSION

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 20, 2017, John Petraglia's license, certification or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 16, 2018, the Administrative Director mailed to John Petraglia a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, John Petraglia did submit a timely written request for hearing but later withdrew his request to appeal the suspension; and

WHEREAS, there is no request to appeal the suspension and based on a review of the record, the Administrative Director finds that John Petraglia meets the criteria for suspension set forth in Labor Code section 139.21(a);

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that John Petraglia is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
