1 **STATE OF CALIFORNIA** DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS 2 **DIVISION OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION** BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR 3 4 5 In Re: PROVIDER SUSPENSION 6 MARK SCHENA, **ORDER OF SUSPENSION** 7 **Respondent.** 8 9 10 11 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director 12 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' 13 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been 14 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); 15 and 16 WHEREAS, on or about September 1, 2022, Respondent Mark Schena pled guilty to 17 or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code 18 section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, Northern District of California; 19 and 20 WHEREAS, on or about December 19, 2023, the Administrative Director mailed to 21 Mark Schena a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the 22 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) 23 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and 24 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of 25 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Mark Schena that the 26 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice. 27 unless Mark Schena submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days 28 of the date of mailing of the notice; and

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1	WHEREAS, Mark Schena did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
2	calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and
3	WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
4	practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of
5	Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was
6	mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a
7	hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;
8	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent Mark Schena is hereby suspended from
9	participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
