WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been

WHEREAS, on or about April 15, 2021, Respondent Robert Irving Slater (Robert Slater) pled quilty to or was found quilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the California Superior Court, County of Orange; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 26, 2023, the Administrative Director mailed to Robert Slater a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Robert Slater that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Robert Slater submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Robert Slater did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Robert Slater is hereby suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
