4 **ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

5 In Re: PROVIDER SUSPENSION

6 L'TANYA SMITH,

9 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
10 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation
11 system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony
12 or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

13 WHEREAS, on or about February 2, 2016, L'tanya Smith pled guilty to or was found
14 guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A)
15 in United States District Court, Central District of California; and

16 WHEREAS, on or about April 13, 2018, the Administrative Director mailed to L'tanya
17 Smith a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to
18 follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code
19 of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and


20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
21 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised L'tanya Smith that the
22 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless
23 L'tanya Smith submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date
24 of mailing of the notice; and

25 WHEREAS, L'tanya Smith did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
26 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

27 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner,
28 or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations
 section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date of notice was mailed, unless the physician,
 practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of
 the date of mailing of the notice;

1 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** L'tanya Smith is hereby suspended from participating in the
2 workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
