8 ORDER OF SUSPENSION

10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
12 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been
13 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

14 WHEREAS, on or about November 15, 2016, Tigran Svadjian pled guilty to or was
15 found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section
16 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, Central District of California; and

17 WHEREAS, on or about August 15, 2019, the Administrative Director mailed to Tigran
18 Svadjian a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure
19 to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California
20 Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

21 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
22 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Tigran Svadjian that the
23 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,
24 unless Tigran Svadjian submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days
25 of the date of mailing of the notice; and

26 WHEREAS, Tigran Svadjian did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
27 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

28 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of

1 Regulations section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless
2 the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10)
3 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;

4 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Tigran Svadjian is hereby suspended from participating
5 in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
