ORDER OF SUSPENSION

ROBERT CRAIG TAYLOR,
Respondent.

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

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WHEREAS, on or about September 18, 2007, Robert Craig Taylor pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in multiple criminal cases in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles; and

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WHEREAS, on or about December 20, 2007, Robert Craig Taylor pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of California, County of Orange; and

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 25, 2009, Robert Craig Taylor's license, certification or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners, State of California; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 22, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to Robert Craig Taylor a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of

1 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and


2 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
3 title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Robert Craig Taylor that the suspension would start
4 thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Robert Craig Taylor
5 submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the
6 notice; and

7 WHEREAS, Robert Craig Taylor did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
8 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

9 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
10 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section
11 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
12 provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
13 the notice;

14 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Robert Craig Taylor is hereby suspended from participating in
15 the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
