

PREDETERMINED INCREASE

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATIONS:

Iron Worker

DETERMINATION:

C-20-X-1-2018-1

LOCALITIES:

All localities within the State of California

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the current determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after March 4, 2018, until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project, has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

IRON WORKER (ALL CLASSIFICATIONS) – Area 1

Determination C-20-X-1-2018-1 is in effect and expires on May 31, 2018**.

Effective June 1, 2018, \$0.25 will be reallocated from Other Payments to Vacation/Holiday.

Effective July 1, 2018, there was an increase of \$1.75 allocated as follows: \$0.75 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.30 to Vacation and \$0.70 to Other.

Effective January 1, 2019, there will be an increase of \$2.75 allocated as follows: \$1.75 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.15 to Health and Welfare, \$0.45 to Vacation and \$0.40 to Other (Annuity).

Effective July 1, 2019, there will be an increase of \$2.75 allocated as follows: \$1.50 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.25 to Health and Welfare, \$0.25 to Vacation, and \$0.75 to Other (Annuity).

IRON WORKER (ALL CLASSIFICATIONS) – Area 2

Determination C-20-X-1-2018-1 is in effect and expires on May 31, 2018**.

Effective June 1, 2018, \$0.25 will be reallocated from Other Payments to Vacation/Holiday.

Effective July 1, 2018, there was an increase of \$2.00 allocated as follows: \$1.00 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.30 to Vacation and \$0.70 to Other.

Effective January 1, 2019, there will be an increase of \$2.00 allocated as follows: \$1.00 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.15 to Health and Welfare, \$0.45 to Vacation and \$0.40 to Other (Annuity).

Effective July 1, 2019, there will be an increase of \$2.25 allocated as follows: \$1.00 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.25 to Health and Welfare, \$0.25 to Vacation, and \$0.75 to Other (Annuity).

There are no further increases applicable to this determination.
