IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING A <u>CORRECTION</u> TO THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATION: Laborer and Related Classifications

DETERMINATION(s): NC-23-102-1-2018-1 and NC-23-102-1-2018-2

LOCALITY: All Localities within Alameda, Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, Contra Costa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Fresno, Glenn, Humboldt, Kings, Lake, Lassen, Madera, Marin, Mariposa, Mendocino, Merced, Modoc, Monterey, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Benito, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Stanislaus, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Tulare, Tuolumne, Yolo, and Yuba Counties.

The language, "Supplement No. 2 – Gunite, Shotcrete, Panelcrete, and Similar" in the 2018-2023 AGC/Laborers' Master Agreement for Northern California Memorandum of Understanding was inadvertently omitted from the Travel and Subsistence Provisions pages posted on the Department's website for the above referenced craft and determinations. The sections regarding, "Travel from Jurisdiction of one Area to Another Area; Travel, Driving and out of Town Expense Allowance; and Travel & Driving time is not subject to Section 28" are specific to Supplement No. 2, which covers Laborers who perform work involving gunite, shotcrete, panelcrete, and similar type of work. For all other Laborer groups and classifications, there are no travel requirements besides the zone pay specified in Supplement No. 6 and Parking Requirements specified in Section 20B.

With the exception of the above correction, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above referenced determinations remain unchanged.
