

## IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING A <u>CORRECTION</u> TO THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS

**LOCALITIES**: All localities within Alameda, Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, Contra Costa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Fresno, Glenn, Humboldt, Kings, Lake, Lassen, Madera, Marin, Mariposa, Mendocino, Merced, Modoc, Monterey, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Benito, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Stanislaus, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Tulare, Tuolumne, Yolo and Yuba Counties.

The July 1, 2020 predetermined increase breakdown was incorrectly published as follows for the above referenced prevailing wage determination:

"Effective July 1, 2020, there was an increase of \$2.24 allocated as follows: \$1.30 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.50 to Health & Welfare, \$0.41 to Pension and \$0.03 to Training."

The correct breakdown is as follows:

"Effective July 1, 2020, there was an increase of \$2.24 allocated as follows: \$1.30 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.50 to Health & Welfare, \$0.41 to Pension and \$0.03 to **Other**."

With the exception of the above correction, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above referenced determination remain in effect.
