HOLIDAYS

Section 3. Holidays.

- (a) The following are nationally recognized holidays covered by this Agreement: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, the Friday following Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If any of the above holidays fall on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as the holiday. If any of the above holidays fall on Sunday, the Monday following shall be observed as the holiday.
- (b) Four (4) days of each calendar year will be selected by the Union as designated days off. All signatory Employers will be notified at the beginning of each calendar year regarding holidays and designated days off.
- (c) The following designated days off will be observed.

2021: Friday, February 12th, Friday, May 28th, Friday, July 2nd, Friday, September 3rd.

2022: Friday, January 14th, Friday February 18th, Friday, May 27th, Friday, September 2nd

2023: Friday, January 17th, Friday, May 26th, Monday, July 3rd, Friday, September 1st

2024: Friday, February 16th, Friday, May 24th, Friday, July 5th, Friday, August 30th

2025: Friday, February 14th, Friday, May 23rd, Friday, August 29th, Friday, December 26th

The four designated off/collectively bargained holidays shall be governed by Article 10, Section 2. Overtime.
