**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES
REGARDING A CORRECTION TO
THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/Other Interested Parties:

CRAFT: Carpet, Linoleum

CLASSIFICATIONS: Resilient Tile Layer (2nd Shift) and Material Handler (2nd Shift)

LOCALITIES: Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Ventura, Kern, Mono, Inyo

DETERMINATION: LOS-2022-2, ORA-2022-2, RIV-2022-2, SBR-2022-2, SLO-2022-2, STB-2022-2, VEN-2022-2, KER-2022-2, MON-2022-2, INY-2022-2

For the above referenced craft, classifications, shifts, and determination, the amounts and allocations of the predetermined increases effective January 1, 2023 are incorrect. The correct amounts and allocations are below.

Carpet, Linoleum, Resilient Tile Layer (2nd Shift)

Effective January 1, 2023, there will be an increase of \$3.08 allocated as follows:

\$1.98 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.00 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.10 to Vacation/Holiday.

Carpet, Linoleum, Material Handler (2nd Shift)

Effective January 1, 2023, there will be an increase of \$1.89 allocated as follows:

\$0.79 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.00 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.10 to Vacation/Holiday.

With the exception of the above correction, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above referenced prevailing wage determination remain unchanged.
