

PREDETERMINED INCREASE

These predetermined increases for the above named crafts apply only to the current determinations for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after September 1, 2022, until the determination(s) is/are superseded by a new determination(s) or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project, has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

DRIVER (ON/OFF-HAULING TO/FROM CONSTRUCTION SITE)

The above determination is currently in effect and will expire on December 31, 2022**.

Effective January 1, 2023, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to be allocated as follows: \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly rate, \$0.31 to Health and Welfare and \$0.44 to Pension.

Effective July 1, 2023, there will be an increase of \$2.15 to be allocated to the Basic Hourly rate.

Effective January 1, 2024, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to be allocated as follows: to \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly rate, \$0.32 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.43 to Pension.

Effective July 1, 2024, there will be an increase of \$2.25 to be allocated to the Basic Hourly rate.

Effective January 1, 2025, there will be an increase of \$1.00 to be allocated as follows: \$0.66 to Health and Welfare and \$0.34 to Pension.

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
