TRAVEL AND SUBSISTENCE

ARTICLE VII Transportation, Travel Pay and Per Diem

Section A. The Employer, will provide transportation to and from the shop on all jobsites outside the free zone.

Section B. Any Employee driving the company trucks shall be paid at his current wage rate for actual time spent driving.

Section C. The free Zone shall be considered a sixty (60) mile radius from the contractor's place of business.

Section D. A \$70.00 per diem shall be paid each day or partial day that an Employee travels to and from projects outside the free Zone.

Section E. In the event the Employee is required to stay overnight the employer shall provide the Employee with a suitable hotel room plus \$40.00 for meals, in lieu of the \$70 per diem as per Section D of this Article.

Section F. On projects requiring payment of Per Diem, the Employer agrees to pay Employees travel pay at Employee's current wage rate for travel to the jobsite on the first day from the Employers shop, and again when returning from the outside the free zone.

Section G. A seven (7) day per diem will be paid when the Employer does not provide transportation from a jobsite out of the free zone to the shop and from the shop back to the jobsite the following week, as covered in section A of this article.

Section H. Mileage will be paid to Employees at a rate equal to the IRS allowable per mileage rate, when an Employer request an Employee use his/her personal vehicle for work purposes, to include transporting Employees to and/or from the job site.
