THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

**DETERMINATIONS:** 2023-1

For the above referenced craft, classification, shift, and determination, the journeyman predetermined increase effective June 26, 2023 is incorrect. The correct predetermined increase should read as follows:

Effective 6/26/2023 - an increase of \$6.23 allocated: \$6.03 to the basic hourly rate, \$0.09 to vacation/holiday, \$0.09 to training and \$0.02 to other.
