Effective July 1, 2024, there will be a \$4.86 increase to be allocated as follows: \$3.62 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.38 to Health & Welfare, \$0.43 to Pension, \$0.31 to Vacation/Holiday, \$0.07 to Training, \$0.05 to Other.

Effective July 1, 2025, there will be a \$5.11 increase to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

Effective July 1, 2026, there will be a \$5.37 increase to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

STOCKER, SCRAPPER (employed for 2000 hours, consecutively or cumulatively) (All Areas and All Shifts):

Effective July 1, 2024, there will be a \$2.93 increase allocated as follows: \$1.81 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.38 to Health and Welfare, \$0.43 to Pension, and \$0.31 to Vacation/Holiday.

Effective July 1, 2025, there will be a \$3.14 increase to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

Effective July 1, 2026, there will be a \$3.27 increase to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

STOCKER, SCRAPPER (All Areas and All Shifts):

Effective July 1, 2024, there will be a \$2.65 increase allocated as follows: \$1.81 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.38 to Health and Welfare, \$0.15 to Pension, and \$0.31 to Vacation/Holiday. (See important notice dated May 30, 2024)

Effective July 1, 2025, there will be a \$2.72 increase to be allocated to wages and/or fringes. (See important notice dated May 30, 2024)

Effective July 1, 2026, there will be a \$2.85 increase to be allocated to wages and/or fringes. (See important notice dated May 30, 2024)
