## STOCKER, SCRAPPER (All Areas and All Shifts)

The Journeyman increases of July 1, 2024: \$2.93, July 1, 2025: \$3.14, and July 1, 2026: \$3.27 for the Stocker, Scrapper (All Areas and All Shifts) are incorrect. The correct predetermined increase amounts should read as follows:

Effective July 1, 2024, there will be a \$2.65 increase allocated as follows: \$1.81 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.38 to Health and Welfare, \$0.15 to Pension, and \$0.31 to Vacation/Holiday.

Effective July 1, 2025, there will be a \$2.72 increase to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.

Effective July 1, 2026, there will be a \$2.85 increase to be allocated to wages and/or fringes.
