### **TRAVEL AND SUBSISTENCE**

#### **06.00.00 WORKING CONDITIONS**

06.01.00 DAILYCOMPENSATION. All Employees shall receive the applicable compensation for all actual hours of work at a yard or on a jobsite, or when driving any company vehicle per (Industrial Welfare Order No. 14-80). Other than those vehicles provided for the convenience of the Employee(s) in getting to and from a jobsite. Employees shall also receive compensation when in transit between jobsites when working at more than one jobsite on a given day.

06.01.01 TRAVEL PAY TIME. On any day on which an Employee is required to report to the yard, the Employee's time will start at the yard. On any day on which the individual Employer requires an Employee to return to the yard and when an Employee is required to report to the yard on that date, an Employee's time will end at the yard. When an Employee is required to report to a job site, or are not driving a Company provided vehicle, the Employee's work day shall begin upon reporting to the job site and end at the end of the work shift.

06.01.03 ROOM AND BOARD. For all work located more than sixty (60) miles from an Employer's permanent yard, the Employer shall be responsible for payment to the proprietors of motels providing rooms to Employees, as selected by Employer, and shall pay Employees sixty dollars (\$60.00) a day for meals. Employees returning home after sixty (60) or more miles of travel on the same shift shall not be eligible for room or meals. Except at the option of the Employer, the following areas shall not qualify for room and board regardless of distance: Santa Cruz County, San Benito County, San Mateo County, and Monterey County north of a line from San Lucas to Big Sur, Santa Clara County west of the crest of the Mt. Hamilton Range.

06.01.04 Employer shall pay all tolls.
