Pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.4 and the provisions of Labor Code Sections 142.1, 142.2, and 142.3, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board has set the time and place for a Public Hearing. At the Public Hearing, the Board will consider public testimony on the proposed changes noticed below to occupational safety and health standards in Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations.

NOTICE OF STANDARDS APPROVED

After proceedings held in accordance with and pursuant to authority vested in Sections 142, 142.3 and 142.4 of the Labor Code to implement interpret, or make specific, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, by a majority vote, adopted additions, revisions or deletions to the California Code of Regulations as follows:

1. Title 8, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, Construction Safety Orders, Article 4, Section 1532.2(d)(4)(A); and Subchapter 7, General Industry Safety Orders, Article 110, Section 5206(d)(4)(A); and Subchapter 18, Ship Building, Ship Repairing and Ship Breaking Safety Orders, Article 4, Section 8359(d)(4)(A), **Employee Notification Regarding Chromium (VI) Exposure Determinations (Horcher).**

Heard at the July 15, 2010, Public Hearing; adopted on August 19, 2010; filed with the Secretary of State on September 13, 2010; and became effective on September 13, 2010.

2. Title 8, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, General Industry Safety Orders, Article 10, Section 3395, **Heat Illness Prevention.**

Heard at the October 15, 2009, Public Hearing; adopted on August 19, 2010; filed with the Secretary of State on October 5, 2010; and will become effective on November 4, 2010.
