REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION ON PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

INTRODUCTION

By a timely and verified Petition for Reconsideration (Petition) filed on September 29, 2022, applicant seeks reconsideration of my September 7, 2022 Award, which did not include a provision for an attorney's fee, as it was based upon Stipulations with Request for Award which were completed without the participation of applicant's counsel, and did not provide for an attorney's fee.

Subsequently, the parties entered into Stipulations with Request for Award with the participation of applicant's attorney, which was submitted into EAMS on November 9, 2022. The parties also submitted a joint letter on November 9, 2022, advising the Appeals Board of the newly filed Stipulations with Request for Award, and a request that that November 9, 2022 Stipulations be approved.

Based upon my review of the record, I recommend that reconsideration be granted, that the September 7, 2022 Award be rescinded, so that the matter be returned to me at the trial level in order to issue a new Award based upon the November 9, 2022 Stipulations with Request for Award.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the foregoing, it is respectfully recommended that reconsideration be **GRANTED**, that the September 7, 2022 Award be **RESCINED**, and that the matter be **RETURNED** to the trial level in order for the undersigned to issue a new Award based upon the November 9, 2022 Stipulations with Request for Award.
