

Concurrent Program Qualifications

Completion of various levels of the Child Development Educator Apprenticeship also qualifies the provider for certain levels under the Child Development Permit Matrix.

All caregivers employed in Title V child care centers must meet the education and experience requirements of the Permit Matrix to be employed in a given title.

Completion of this level of the Child Development Educator Apprenticeship Program also satisfies the requirements under the Permit Matrix for their titles:
