Updates:

The Department of Industrial Relations' (DIR) is glad to announce our Equal Representation in Construction Apprenticeships (ERiCA) \$20 million grant solicitation. This grant will provide funding to offset childcare costs for registered construction pre-apprentices, incentives for construction apprenticeship programs to register these pre-apprentice graduates and provide funding for community-based organizations who are serving women in construction. The application period will begin in mid-November and close in mid-December.

DAS is working on an interagency agreement with the Employment Training Panel (ETP) to utilize a Salesforce workforce grants management system. The California Workforce Development Board also utilizes this grants management system. All ERiCA grant applications will be hosted on this platform. This project is another example how the workforce entities of the California Labor & Workforce Development Board are working together.

All pre-apprenticeship programs need to be registered with DAS in order to receive ERiCA grant funding. There are requirements for community-based organizations to have experience serving women for the funding around marketing and support services. All pre-apprenticeship programs will need to get a memorandum of understanding or a linkage agreement in place with a DAS registered construction apprenticeship program pursuant to Labor Code section 3100.

Federal Grants

Apprenticeship System (CAS) database. This funding allows DAS to better capture and represent demographic data across all workforce sectors and provide requested reports to IACA and its members that were not readily available before the recent enhancements to the DAS CAS database system. The new reporting system went live on the DAS website in October 2021 and has been considered a great success by the apprenticeship community as a whole.

In July 2021, the U.S. Department of Labor awarded the Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS) with the State Apprenticeship Expansion, Equity and Innovation (SAEEI) grant to create apprenticeship pathways within the local workforce ecosystem. This January 16, 2022, DAS released the grant and is Soliciting for Proposals (SFP) from Regional Local Workforce Development Boards and Apprenticeship Program Sponsors to develop new apprenticeship programs or expand on existing apprenticeship programs that work to create opportunities for underserved communities. The grant focuses on creating equitable registered apprenticeship programs for women, veterans, justice-involved, youth, people with disabilities, communities of color and unemployed individuals who were impacted by COVID-19. The grant funding amounts to approximately \$7.3 million to fund multiple grants not to exceed \$4,800 per apprentice, ranging from \$240,000 to \$2,500,000. On May 4, 2022 the DAS was pleased to announce that six successful grantee applicants were awarded the SAEEI Grant. The awards range from \$240,000 to \$2,000,000. The SAEEI applicants awarded are listed below. DAS is currently finalizing the contracts for the grantees and expects to have them executed within the 4th quarter of 2022.

The active apprentices numbered 18,211 / 89,668

Active women apprentices numbered **4,905** / **7,349**, which is **26.9%** / **8.2%** of all active apprentices.

There are currently **1,164** / **5,276** veterans active, **346** / **4,342** of which registered and **127** / **2,372** completed in 2022.

Program Evaluations July 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022

Since July 1, 2022, DAS did not open any program evaluations. DAS completed six (6) evaluations and thirty three (33) program evaluations are in progress. There are three programs that closed and seven (7) programs with corrective action needed (five (5) opened in 2020, two (2) opened in 2021). DAS consultants are monitoring these programs to ensure their recommendations are completed.

DAS will continue to send new evaluation notification letters one year following the creation of a new program or substantial expansion of an existing program. To ensure high-quality apprenticeship administration, consultants will assist apprenticeship programs with correcting the deficiencies found in order to close their evaluations/reviews.
