§ 13811.5 Temporary Registration Extension.

The Labor Commissioner's Office $\frac{\text{may, at their discretion}}{\text{shall}}$ issue a temporary registration that extends the validity period of a registration for a period of up to 90 days $\frac{\text{in the following}}{\text{circumstances}}$ if:

- (a) The applicant submitted a renewal application at least 30 days prior to the expiration date of the registration with the applicable registration fee and proof of applicable worker's compensation insurance;
- (b) The applicant has <u>not failed to submit any</u> submitted all items that the Labor Commissioner's Office has requested in order to complete processing of the renewal application;
- (c) The applicant is in good standing with the California Secretary of State; and
- (d) The renewal application processing has not been completed by the Labor Commissioner's Office *prior to expiration of the current registration*.
