ADOPTING SECTIONS 13810 THROUGH 13819, INCLUSIVE, REGULATING  
JANITORIAL EMPLOYER REGISTRATION

§ 13811.5 Temporary Registration Extension.

The Labor Commissioner's Office ~~may, at their discretion,~~ ***shall*** issue a temporary registration that extends the validity period of a registration for a period of up to 90 days ~~in the following circumstances~~ ***if:***

- (a) The applicant submitted a renewal application at least 30 days prior to the expiration date of the registration with the applicable registration fee and proof of applicable worker's compensation insurance;
- (b) The applicant has ~~not failed to submit any~~ ***submitted all*** items that the Labor Commissioner's Office has requested in order to complete processing of the renewal application;
- (c) The applicant is in good standing with the California Secretary of State; and
- (d) The renewal application processing has not been completed by the Labor Commissioner's Office ***prior to expiration of the current registration.***
