Employees may receive 24 hours of Part 46 or Part 48 New Miner Training or 8 hours of Annual Refresher Training from a MSHA Approved Trainer at no charge. Classes are scheduled in Northern and Southern California. Upon completion employees will receive a MSHA 5000-23 certificate.
