Workplace Violent Incidents at Hospitals October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020

Annual Report Posted in January 2022

Background

Cal/OSHA developed a regulation for certain hospitals to adopt a workplace violence prevention plan following passage of <u>Senate Bill 1299</u> in 2014 addressing workplace violence in health care. Cal/OSHA's Violence Prevention in Heath Care standard (California Code of Regulations, title 8, <u>section 3342</u>) became effective on April 1, 2017.

Labor Code <u>section 6401.8(c)</u> requires that Cal/OSHA post a report on its website each year containing information on violent incidents at hospitals, based on reports submitted by the hospitals. Cal/OSHA's report must include which hospitals submitted reports, the total number of incidents reported, the outcome of any related inspection or investigation, citations levied against a hospital based on a violent incident, and recommendations for the prevention of violent incidents in hospitals.

Section 3342(g) requires that hospitals submit reports to Cal/OSHA regarding any incident involving either of the following:

- (A) The use of physical force against an employee by a patient or a person accompanying a patient that results in, or has a high likelihood of resulting in, injury, psychological trauma, or stress, regardless of whether the employee sustains an injury;
- (B) An incident involving the use of a firearm or other dangerous weapon, regardless of whether the employee sustains an injury.

For reporting purposes, the definition of "injury" is any injury that results in loss of consciousness, medical treatment beyond first aid, days away from work, restricted work or transfer to another job, significant injury or illness diagnosed by a physician or other licensed health care professional, or death.

This report prepared by Cal/OSHA is based on the reports received from hospitals in the 12-month period starting on October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020.

Data Collection

All hospitals licensed by the California Department of Public Health as a general acute care hospital, an acute psychiatric hospital, or a special hospital are required by section 3342 to report incidents of workplace violence to Cal/OSHA. Reports are accepted online through Cal/OSHA's <u>Workplace Violent</u> <u>Incident Reporting System for Hospitals</u>.

Cal/OSHA requires hospitals to identify the hospital facility where the incident occurred when making a report. For reporting purposes, a hospital facility is identified by its California Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) unique identification number. A facility includes all the services and service locations encompassed by the OSHPD identification number.

During the period covered by this report, the OSHPD listing included approximately 480 open general acute care or acute psychiatric facilities, with no special hospitals licensed in California during the reporting period. To a limited degree, this number fluctuated over the reporting period as facilities opened or closed.

Results

Total Number of Reports

Cal/OSHA received 9,796 violent incident reports from 328 hospital facilities during the reporting period. This number does not include reports that were duplicative, erroneous, or replaced by a corrected report. (See Tables 1 and 2 on pages 4–12.)

Five Department of State Hospitals (DSH) facilities reported incidents using an alternative reporting method, while 323 facilities reported incidents using the Cal/OSHA online reporting system.

Each violent incident report contains the following information:

- Name and address of the hospital where the incident occurred
- Date, time, and location of the incident
- Brief description of the incident
- Number of employees injured (if any) and the types of injuries
- Whether security or law enforcement was contacted
- Whether there is a continuing threat, and if so, what measures are being taken to protect employees
- Whether the incident was reported to the nearest Cal/OSHA district office as required in section 342
 Reporting Work-Connected Fatalities and Serious Injuries (See below regarding incidents reported
 under section 342)

Data Limitations

The violence data collected has limitations. Hospitals are not required to report all incidents and the reporting system does not verify the accuracy of reports.

Inspections related to violent incidents at hospitals

Cal/OSHA investigates notifications of any serious injury, illness or death that occurs at a workplace. Hospital violent incident reports that meet this threshold would result in an inspection. Additionally, Cal/OSHA conducts other types of inspections at hospitals to address workplace violence hazards.

Cal/OSHA completed 23 inspections related to workplace violence hazards at hospitals during the reporting period. In 11 of the completed inspections, Cal/OSHA issued no citations relating to a violent incident. In the remaining 12 completed inspections, Cal/OSHA issued 1 notice in lieu of a citation, 13 general citations, 7 regulatory citations and 6 serious citations of section 3342; Cal/OSHA did not issue any citations for other regulations where the citation related to a violent incident. The breakdown and status for the 12 inspections with notices or citations of section 3342, as of November 30, 2021, is as follows:

- 1. One inspection resulted in one general citation and two regulatory citations of section 3342. The three violations were abated.
- 2. One inspection resulted in one general citation. The violation was abated.
- 3. One inspection resulted in one general citation, two regulatory citations, and one serious citation of section 3342. The serious violation was abated. The other violations are being contested and are pending abatement.

- 4. One inspection resulted in one serious citation of section 3342. The violation was abated.
- 5. One inspection resulted in one notice in lieu of a citation, one general citation, and one serious citation of section 3342. The notice and two violations were abated.
- 6. One inspection resulted in two general citations of section 3342. Both violations were abated.
- 7. One inspection resulted in one general citation of section 3342. The violation was abated.
- 8. One inspection resulted in two general citations, two regulatory citations and a serious citation of section 3342. The five violations were abated.
- 9. One inspection resulted in two general citations of section 3342. Both violations are being contested and are pending abatement.
- 10. One inspection resulted in one serious citation of section 3342. The violation was abated.
- 11. One inspection resulted in one general citation, one regulatory citation and one serious citation of section 3342. The three violations were abated.
- 12. One inspection resulted in one general citation of section 3342. The violation was abated.

Citations issued by Cal/OSHA are subject to appeal. Appealed citations fall under the authority of the Occupational Safety and Health Appeals Board. It may take several years to resolve citations that have been appealed. The requirement to abate a citation is stayed if the citation is appealed.

Recommendations for the Prevention of Violent Incidents at Hospitals

- Cal/OSHA recommends that all employers, employees, and safety advocates recognize violence as a
 major occupational hazard and incorporate workplace violence prevention into their occupational
 safety programs and campaigns. According to the <u>Bureau of Labor Statistics</u>, violence and other
 injuries by persons or animals was the third-most common cause of occupational fatalities in the
 United States in 2019.
- 2. Cal/OSHA recommends that employers review their procedures for reporting workplace violence incidents. An incident must be reported regardless of whether it resulted in injury (See subsection 3342(g) and the <u>FAQs</u> on workplace violence reporting). Cal/OSHA depends on accurate reporting of workplace violent incidents to help provide information for employers and employees relevant to the prevention of workplace violence.
