## **ACCIDENT INVESTIGATIONS:**

On May 30, 2016, at approximately 7:40 p.m., an accident occurred on an attraction known as Big Splash (C-19328) owned and operated by Helm & Sons. At the time of the accident, the attraction was located at the San Bernardino County Fair, 14800 7<sup>th</sup> Street in Victorville, California. A female patron caught her leg between the log boat and the platform loading area. She received onsite treatment for a laceration on her shin and later received further treatment at Victor Valley Global Medical Center. As a result of this accident, the Owner/Operator was required to retrain the operators of the ride to ensure that the patrons follow the ride's exiting procedures.

On July 23, 2016, at approximately 10:40 p.m., an accident occurred on an attraction known as Giant Wheel (C-17571) owned by Davis Enterprises. At the time of the accident, the attraction was located at the California Mid-State Fair, 2198 Riverside Ave. in Paso Robles, California. A male patron fell when the cribbing that supports the exit ramp shifted. He sustained injury to his back, shoulder, and neck. As a result of this accident, the Owner/Operator was required to update the preopening inspection documentation to ensure that the exit ramp is properly secured and the associated cribbing is installed correctly.

On July 27, 2016, at approximately 8:55 p.m., an accident occurred on an attraction known as Tango (C-19694) owned by Capitol City Amusements. At the time of the accident the attraction was located at the California Mid-State Fair on 2198 Riverside Ave. in Paso Robles, California. A female patron injured her ankle on the loading deck as the ride lowered into a parked position. Onsite paramedics treated the injured patron and recommended she be taken to the hospital for diagnosis and treatment. The injured patron's mother transported her to the Twin Cities emergency room in Templeton, California for evaluation. As a result of this accident, the Owner/Operator was required to make repairs to several damaged electrical connectors associated with indexing the passenger gondolas into the proper load/unload position.

On Oct. 22, 2016, at approximately 11:40 a.m., an accident occurred on an attraction known as Fly Wire Zipline (C-19070) owned and operated by Bishop Entertainment Enterprises. At the time of the accident, the attraction was located at Bishop Pumpkin Farm, 803 Rich Place in Wheatland, California. Shortly after starting the ride, the electric winch used to secure the zip line wire rope disengaged and a male patron fell approximately 15 to 20 feet to the ground. He sustained injury to his neck, back, and knee and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. As a result of this accident the Owner/Operator was required to install a cover over the winch control lever and update the operating procedures for the ride.

## **INSPECTIONS**

The following table lists Owner/Operators that operated Portable Amusement Rides in the State of California during the 2016 operating season. The table includes the number of rides inspected for each Owner/Operator and the number of operating permits (both annual and temporary), issued to those rides.

A temporary permit is an operating permit issued by the Division after inspection of a temporary amusement ride results in the Division requiring correction actions. The Division issues temporary permits when violations deemed as non-critical to the safe operation of the ride were observed. The expiration date of a temporary permit can be within a few days or up to 30 days after issuance.

An annual operating permit is a permit issued by the Division after inspection of a temporary amusement ride that is found to be in compliance with all applicable regulations.
