How frequently does indoor heat illness occur? How many cases is the Division aware of?

What about the work level of the employee? If the job is sendentary rather than physical the physiological effects of the environment would be different. This should be reflected in the standard. An employee who is sitting monitoring a screen and typing in an 83 degree office would be less prone to heat illness than someone loading heavy products on a pallet in an 83 degree F warehouse.

What about employees who work in vehicles? Some are not air conditioned. Examples: Trains, buses, ambulances, vans etc. Does the standard apply?

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
