

The Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) proposes to amend, adopt and repeal regulations in Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations. This actions is being taken to implement the provisions of Labor Code section 5307.9, of Senate Bill 863 (Chapter 363, stats. of 2012, effective January 1, 2013). Labor Code section 5307.9 mandates a Copy Service Fee Schedule for copy and related services and provides that the schedule shall specify the services allowed and shall require specificity in billing for these services. These proposed amendments provide for a maximum flat fee of \$180 for records up to 500 pages and includes associated services such as witness fees for delivery of records, and subpoena preparation. For excess over 500 pages, an additional per page fee of ten cents per page is allowed. Certificates of no records would be payable at a maximum of \$75. The proposed changes to regulations also include allowing DWC to bill \$85.00 an hour instead of \$40.00 for electronic requests made under the Public Records Act.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 7/1/2015.
