4	MS. HAUSCARRIAGUE: Good morning. Thank you for coming
5	today. My name is Yvonne Hauscarriague. I'm the Acting Chief
6	Counsel for the Division of Workers' Compensation.
7	This is the public hearing for the proposed evidence-based
8	updates to the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule,
9	otherwise known as the MTUS. The Division is proposing to
10	adopt the current American College of Occupational and
11	Environmental Medicine's, or ACOEM, Traumatic Brain Injury
12	Guideline, as well as update several guidelines addressing the
13	foundations of occupational medicine practice in the General
14	Approaches section of the MTUS. There are copies of the notice
15	on the front desk. Please make sure to sign in on the sign-in
16	sheet and indicate if you wish to testify today.
17	I'd like to take a moment to introduce the other DWC staff
18	here with me today. I'm joined today by Maureen Gray, the
19	Division's Regulations Coordinator; Dr. Raymond Meister, our
20	Executive Medical Director; and John Cortes is counsel with the
21	DWC Legal Unit. Our hearing reporter today is Keyza Almanza.
22	When you come up to testify, please give your business
23	card to Ms. Gray. All testimony given today will be taken down
24	by the hearing reporter and if you have any written testimony
25	that you'd like to hand in, please also give that to Ms. Gray.

today and those submitted in writing, will be considered in determining what revisions we make to the regulations. Please restrict the subject of your comments to the regulation and to any suggestions you have for changing proposed regulations. Also, please limit your comments to three minutes in length.
