MS. URBINA: Good morning, everybody. Thank you for coming today. My name is Lindsey Urbina and I am an Industrial Relations Counsel with the Division of Workers' Compensation. This is the public hearing for the proposed amendments to the WCIS Regulations. There are copies of proposed regulations over on the side table and please make sure you signed in today and indicated whether you would like to give any testimony here this morning.
