

**Order of the Acting Administrative Director of the
Division of Workers' Compensation
(Official Medical Fee Schedule – Pathology and Clinical Laboratory Fee Schedule
Effective for Services Rendered on or after January 1, 2017)**

Pursuant to Labor Code section 5307.1(g)(2), the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation orders that the pathology and clinical laboratory fee schedule portion of the Official Medical Fee Schedule contained in title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 9789.50, is adjusted to conform to changes to the Medicare payment system that were adopted by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services for calendar year 2017. The update includes all fee schedule changes identified in Change Request 9909.

Medicare Data Source and Incorporation by Reference

Effective for services rendered on or after January 1, 2017, the maximum reasonable fees for pathology and laboratory services shall not exceed 120% of the applicable California fees set forth in the calendar year 2017 Clinical Laboratory Fee Schedule, contained in the electronic file "17CLAB", which is adopted and incorporated by reference.
