
Now Easier to Submit Multiple Claim Events in One SROI Batch

First Reports of Injury and Subsequent Reports of Injury (FROI/SROI) data, the Workers' Compensation Information System (WCIS) periodically issues training bulletins outlining some of the most common errors and procedural oversights. An [archive](#) of the bulletins is available.

How to submit multiple SROIs for a claim at once

Following the feedback received from trading partners, WCIS relaxed the sequencing rule that requires a suspension transaction be accepted prior to a reinstatement of benefit transaction. The removal of this edit should allow trading partners more leeway in submitting multiple SROI transactions in a single batch.

The [California EDI Implementation Guide for FROI/SROI version 3.0](#) (Section M, page 77) outlines how to submit multiple short-term claim events in one batch submission.

The guide recommends that to avoid unnecessary sequencing errors trading partners should perform two sorts on their SROI data before submission.

- The primary sort is the Maintenance Type Code (MTC) date (DN 3).
- The secondary sort based on the MTC event.

Regular transaction sequencing rules and data validation edits will still apply when there are multiple events reported for a claim in one file. For transaction sequencing see [training bulletin](#).
