ORDER OF SUSPENSION

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10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
12 as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or
13 misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

14 WHEREAS, on or about August 24, 2018, Daniel Capen pled guilty to or was found guilty of
15 one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in United States
16 District Court, Central District of California; and


17 WHEREAS, on or about February 15, 2019, the Administrative Director mailed to Daniel Capen
18 a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request
19 a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8,
20 section 9788.1; and

21 WHEREAS, Daniel Capen did submit a timely written request for hearing but prior to the
22 scheduled hearing, withdrew his request to appeal the suspension; and

23 WHEREAS, there is no request to appeal the suspension and based on a review of the record, the
24 Administrative Director finds that Daniel Capen meets the criteria for suspension set forth in Labor
25 Code section 139.21(a);

26 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Daniel Capen is hereby suspended from participating in the
27 workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
